Thursday 4 th July 12:30-2:30pm *This session is for BOTH child and parent. A parent MUST be present for the session.	Parent / Child Stay and Play - drop in session Our Reception classrooms and outdoor area will be open between 12:30-2:30pm for you and your child to visit and familiarise themselves with their new learning environment. You will be able to enter the Reception classrooms via the blue doors on the shared car park.
	You and your child can come anytime from 12:30pm and you can spend as much time, together with your child, as you feel is needed to familiarise your child with their new learning space. At 2:30pm, the session will end. The school nurses and SENCO will be available during the afternoon if you need to speak to them.
