Dear families,

Welcome back! It is so lovely to have everyone back in school showing the Eastfield school value of 'pride.' Your children look amazing in their smart school uniform, including black school shoes. It really shows to our community that this is 'how we do it here' at Eastfield!

<u>Routines</u>

This $\frac{1}{2}$ term, we will be working on thread 1 of our positive behaviour for learning policy - ROUTINES. At Eastfield, we have 3 step routines for everything - every morning, we meet and greet your children on the gate / classroom doors, we then emotionally check in with them and see how they are feeling are they in the green, blue, yellow or red zone? and we then get straight onto our tasks.

We repeat this routine after playtime and dinnertime and regularly check in with the children throughout the day. Could you try this routine at home?

Next week will be key for routines at home, as the novelty of coming to school will have worn off and children will be tired – it is perfectly normal for children to say that they don't want to come to school, it does not automatically mean that there is an issue! Remember to talk positively about school with your child so that they are excited about coming every day!

School Dinners

If your child is now in Year 3 (Class 7 or Class 8), then you will need to pay for your child's school meal, as the Universal Infant Free School Meal Scheme ends in Year 2, unless you have applied and are entitled to 'Free School Meals (FSM).' If you wish for your child (in Y5 or Y6) to walk home from school on their own, we need written permission from a parent / carer. Please provide this to your child's class teacher.
