Eastfield is a school built on relationships and so during the 1st week of term, Mrs Evans and Miss Arshad and members of the Reception Team will be visiting all of the children in their class at home to say hello and also to deliver a special 'starting school' book for your child to work through. It is important that both you and your child are able to speak to your child's class teacher individually before their actual start date and we thought that you and your child might be more comfortable in your own environment. We are also planning times for you to come and have a 'tour' of your child's classroom and the 'outdoor classroom.'

We have split both classes into 2 groups and your child is in GROUP B - this means that there will be a smaller number of children for the 1st few days whilst children settle into school.

These blue doors will be clearly sign posted and we will ask you to line up outside the doors and wait for school staff.
