I am now able to detail our plans for your child's induction in September. Our normal school hours are 8:40-3:20pm, however as part of your child's transition we will be building up to these hours over the 1st few weeks.

Monday 2nd September, Monday 9th September, Monday 23rd September - School is closed for INSET (teacher training) days

Week 1
Tuesday 3rd, Wednesday 4 ^{th,}
Thursday 5 th and Friday 6 th
September

For the 1st 4 days, all children in Class 1 and 2 are to attend school from 8:40-2pm
Children will attend school in full school uniform and will stay for lunch
Entrance 'drop off' / collection 'pick up' will be via the blue fire doors on the car
park (see photo at the bottom of the letter)

<u>Week 2</u> Tuesday 10th, Wednesday 11th, Thursday 12th, Friday 13^h September

All children in Class 1 and 2 are to attend school from <u>8:40am-3pm</u>
Entrance 'drop off' / collection 'pick up' will continue to be via the blue fire doors on the car park this week only

<u>Week 3</u> Monday 16th September -Friday 20th September



All children in Class 1 and 2 are to attend <u>normal</u> school hours <u>8:40am - 3:20pm</u> Entrance 'drop off' will continue to be via the blue fire doors on the car park for this week only.

Children will be collected from the multi-coloured fence 'outdoor classroom' on the school playground - this is a change from previous weeks, as we get the children ready for 'normal' drop off and pick up arrangements

Tuesday 24th September - Friday 27th September

Blue Entrance Gates are on Colliery Road, Griffin Street (by nursery), Eastfield Grove

This week children will need to be dropped off via the main school gates - Colliery Road, Griffin Street or Eastfield Grove. Your child will enter the school gates on their own and there will be staff to meet and greet your child. Gates open between 8:40-8:50am. Gates close at 8:50am prompt.

All children are to attend normal school hours 8:40 - 3:20pm

Children will be collected from the multi-coloured fence 'outdoor classroom' on the school playground.

WE WILL NO LONGER BE USING THE BLUE FIRE DOORS ON THE CAR PARK

For the 1st 3 weeks of induction, in order to build relationships with the class teacher, we will be using the blue fire doors (next to the green container) on the shared car park for your child to enter and exit the reception classrooms. These blue doors will be clearly sign posted and we will ask you to line up outside the doors and wait for school staff.

I know that your child starting school can be both an exciting and worrying time and yet I would like to reassure you that both myself and the staff in Class 1 and Class 2 will do our very best to make it a very special time for both you and your child.
