Positive Behaviour at Eastfield

Each ½ term we focus on one thread:

- Thread 1 - 3 step routines
- Thread 2 - Positive relational teaching
- Thread 3 - positive mantras
- Thread 4 - scripts
- Thread 5 - a plan for every day
- Thread 6 - restorative conversations

This term, we are now working on thread 6 - restorative conversations. This is the most powerful part of our behaviour policy as it focuses on both victim and perpetrator. Each person involved in an incident / situation is listened to and gets a chance to say how they feel and how they have been affected.

It is important that we are held responsible for our actions and take accountability.
